Triathlon Canada encourages Organizing Committees to combine Championship events into a festival concept to bring in a larger draw of athletes. LOCs staging multiple championships over the same weekend will only pay a single base fee (the highest).

Bids must be submitted by the Provincial Sport Organization for Triathlon of the host province. Please see the attached document, <u>Bid Criteria</u>, for instructions on preparing a bid. For any assistance in preparing this document contact the Triathlon Canada Events and Technical contact listed below.

There is an expectation that the LOC awarded the Canadian Triathlon Championships also host a CAMTRI Continental Cup in conjunction with the event. The LOC would be responsible for the fees associated with hosting this event.

Triathlon Canada has traditionally been able to assist the LOC is securing grants in order to help cover many of the sanctioning and prize purse costs of hosting the Canadian Triathlon Championships and ITU Continental Cup. While there is no guarantee of support, entering the application process early is recommended for better chance of success.



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SUBMISSION DEADLINE

Bids can be submitted at any time for events in the up and coming season. Expressions of interest for future years are welcomed. Multi-year bids will also be considered.

Bids are to be submitted by mail to the national office and email to the Technical and Events Director. Successful bid LOCs will be invoiced for a deposit to confirm the event on calendar.

The Triathlon Canada Events Evaluation Committee will begin considering bids for **2017 on November 14**, **2016.**

A Call for 2018> event hosting bids will be distributed early in 2017.
